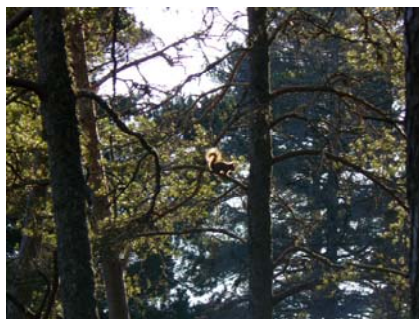
#### RED SQUIRREL WALK

We are hoping that the event will encourage more people in and around Carr-bridge to report squirrel sightings and if they would like, to undertake surveys.*
